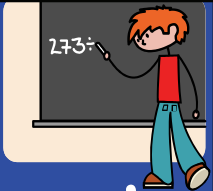

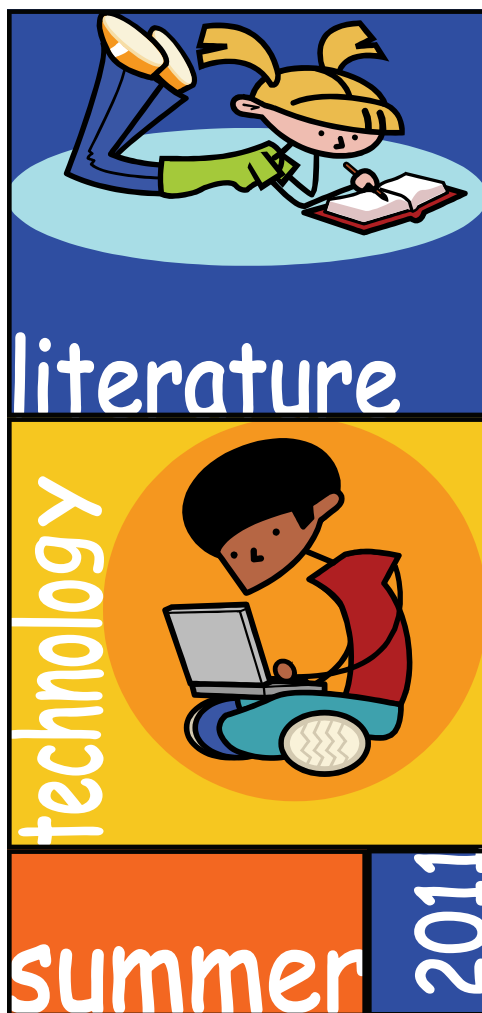

Class sizes are limited. Register early for the best course selection. Online registration begins April 15th.

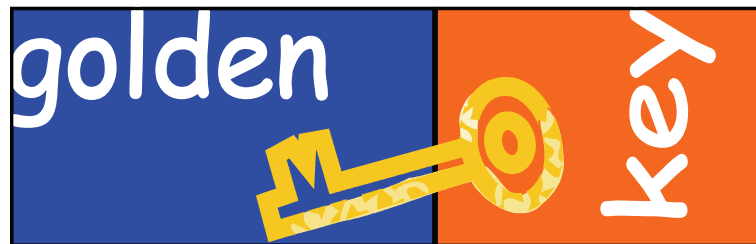
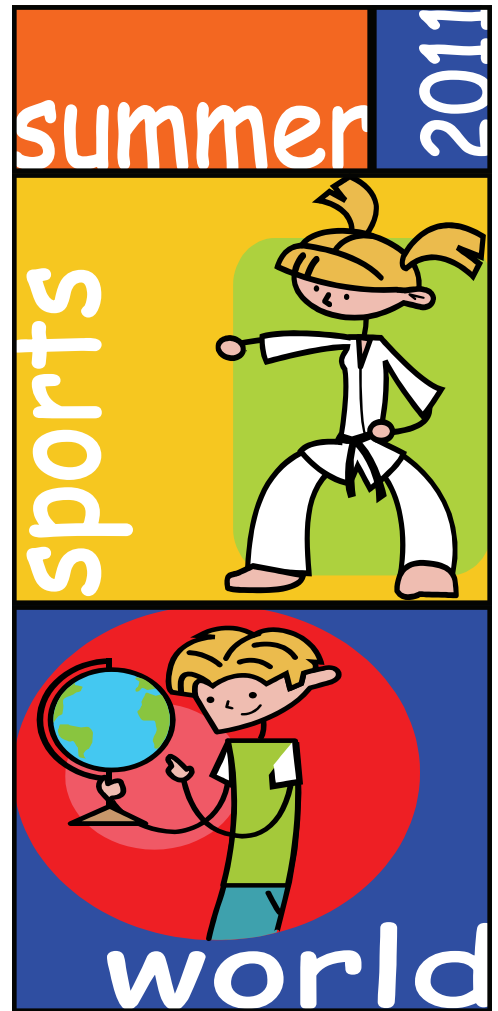
Lunch
